Introduction to the Mr Green Sportsbook Terms and Conditions.

The Mr Green Sportsbook Terms and conditions include these following terms:

- Maximum Pay Out Limits
- Sports Specific Rules
- eSports Specific Rules (the "Rules")

The Mr Green Sportsbook Terms and Conditions are an integral part of the Mr Green General Terms and Conditions.

- Reference in the to "Mr Green", "Company", "we", "our" or "us" in the Mr Green Sportsbook Terms and Conditions shall mean the company that you contract with in the GTCs. References to "you", "your" or "member" means the person that has contracted with the Company through the GTCs.
- Please see 'Section 3. Bet Types" to review the types of bet which you can place on the Site and the applicable definitions used in the Rules below.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that the details of the bets which you place are correct. We advise you to check that the details that you enter with regards to your bet are correct prior to placing such bet. You can view the bets which are accepted by us in your "Bet History".
- The Maximum Payout Limits shall govern with respect to payment of your winnings.
- In these Rules, if the context so requires, references to the singular shall include the plural and vice versa.

<u>Definitions</u>

<u>Definition</u>		
"Mr Green", "Company", "we", "our" or "us"	Shall have the meaning given to it in the Introduction Section.	
<u>Cash Out</u>	Means the feature that we may offer at our sole discretion, which permits you to get back the real money bet you have placed before the relevant event which you have bet on has finished. The amount you will receive is determined at the time the relevant bet is 'cashedout'. For further information please see Section 2 below.	
Dead Heat Rule	 This rule applies where two or more selections which you have had the opportunity to bet on, have finished in the same position, drawn or tied (as applicable). The number of selections which you have had the opportunity to bet on who finish in the same position, drawn or tied (as applicable) will determine your return with respect to such bet. In such event, your bet will be settled at the full odds but your stake will be divided by the number of selections which you have opportunity to bet on, which have finished in the same position, drawn or tied (as applicable). By way of example only, Customer A bets on Sergio Aguero for 100 Euros at 2.5 to be the top scorer in the Premier League Customer B bets on Marcus Rashford for 150 Euros at 21.0 to be to be the top scorer in the Premier League Customer C bets on Sadio Mané for 200 Euros at 6.0 the top scorer in the Premier League 	

	 6. In the event that at the end of the Premier League Season, all three players have scored the same amount of goals: 7. Customer A will receive: (100 Euros\3 x 2.5) = 83.33 Euros 8. Customer B will receive: (150 Euros\3 x 21) = 1050 Euros 9. Customer C will receive: (200 Euros\3 x 6) = 399.99 Euros 	
<u>Error</u>	 Means any type of mistake, misinterpretation, misreading, technical hazard, registration error, transaction error, manifest error, (including without limitation any such error made by us or on our behalf). A non-exhaustive list of such circumstances of an error is as follows: where any odds or terms of a bet are misstated to you; an obvious error; any bet which is accepted due to a technical or human error; any bet accepted on any event which has concluded; a bet containing any incorrect participant; or bets placed at odds that are materially different from those available in the general market at the time the bet was placed. 	
<u>Injury Time</u>	Means the amount of time displayed by the relevant official and not the amount of time which is actually played.	
Influence Betting	Means any occurrence where you act in conjunction with a third party in any manner whatsoever (whether directly or indirectly) in an attempt to directly or indirectly influence an event.	

<u>Live Betting, Live or</u> <u>In-Play</u>	Means any occurrence where you are provided the opportunity to place a bet on a match or event after it has started and while it is in progress.	
<u>Push Rules</u>	Means when you have placed a bet on a Spread, Margin or Handicap and your bet ends in a tie when the spread, margin or handicap is taken into account and no tie option was available to place a bet on. Your stake will be returned in this case.	
Regular Time and Full Time	Means the time period of an event, match or game (as applicable) which the relevant governing association, body or organization defines the length of an event, match or game (as applicable). By way of example, in football (soccer) this means 90 minutes plus Injury Time. This does not include any extra time, overtime or anything analogous thereto, unless we detail otherwise. If the relevant governing association, body or organization determines prior to the relevant event, match or game (as applicable) that such will be played of a different length of time this will be the official duration.	
Rules	Shall have the meaning given to it in the Introduction Section.	
<u>Site</u>	Means <u>www.mrgreen.com</u> and its related mobile application	
Syndicate Betting	Means where you place a series of bets on the same event, tournament or competition (as applicable) in conjunction with other players. This type of "Bet" is considered by us to be an act of fraud. Where we have any evidence whatsoever of such, we may void any related bets	

	and withhold any payment from us to you in relation to such bet until we have completed our investigations.
Walk Over	Means the awarding of a victory to a contestant because there are no other contestants, or the other contestants have been disqualified or have forfeited.
"you", "your" or "member"	Shall have the meaning given to it in the Introduction Section

1. Acceptance, Cancellation or Voidance of Your Bet

Bet Acceptance

1.1. How you can view your bet

When your bet is accepted by us, it will appear in your Bet History. To find your Bet History through your personal computer or mobile device, you must log into your Mr Green account and click on the "View Betting History" Tab in the "My Account" section. In any event that there is a conflict between what is shown in your "View Betting History" and our servers, our servers will take precedence.

1.2. If your bet is accepted by us, you will not be able to cancel such bet.

Voiding of any Bet

- 1.3. A bet made by you can be voided by us, and in such case, we will return to you, your stake placed on such bet.
- 1.4. In the event you place a bet as part of an Accumulator, and any match or event which is part of such Accumulator is cancelled, your bet will not be voided by us.

- 1.5. We may withhold payment of any winnings to you and/or void any bet or any part of a bet whether before or after bet settlement, which is in any way related to: (1) an Error; (2) Influence Betting; (3) the integrity of the event is called into question for any reason whatsoever; (4) event rigging; (5) any public announcement materially changes the odds or offer we provide you with; (6) price or pool has been manipulated; (7) Syndicate Betting; or (8) any criminal activity whatsoever has affected the result or any occurrence in any manner whatsoever.
- 1.6. We may void any or all of the Accumulator Bet placed by you, if we deem that any of the selections in your bet are in any way related (also known as a related contingency), by way of example only, you bet on Liverpool to win the game and Mohammed Sala to score in such game.
- 1.7. We may void a bet with respect to any "pre-match betting" if you place a bet after the relevant event has begun.
- 1.8. We may void a bet with respect to Live Betting: (1) if any bet is placed at the wrong odds or incorrect price due to the live coverage being faulty, hindered or delayed in any way; (2) if any bet is placed on an event which has already occurred; (3) if any bet is placed after an event which in any way can be considered as contributing to the result of an event that has occurred or is occurring; or (4) if the odds offered on the Site relates to a score on the Site which differs from the result at such time provided by the relevant governing association, body or organisation.
- 1.9. We may void a bet placed on a segment of the event, if such event (as applicable) is: (1) played in a different format with regards to time than that detailed in the relevant bet; or (2) if played in any other format than the one detailed in the offer.
- 1.10. We may void any Grand Salami bet, if the relevant match, event or round (as applicable) is not completed. The foregoing shall not apply to any bets related to results prior to the abandonment of the relevant event or round (as applicable) which could in no way have been affected regardless of any future occurrence and such bets will be settled by us according to the result.
- 1.11. We may void any bet on a Quarter or Half or Period if the event takes place in different manner than the one which we detail on the offer to you.
- 1.12. We may void a bet on a 'Race To" bet (or similar), in the event that the listed score has not occurred during the stipulated period, unless we detail otherwise.

- 1.13. We may void a bet with respect to a Winner of a Point of or Scorer of a Goal, in the event that the relevant occurrence has not occurred within the specified timeframe, unless we detail otherwise.
- 1.14. We may void any bet which relates to an occurrence materialising during a period determined by us (for example 'Next Team to have a player sent off") should it not be possible, without any reasonable doubt, to decide the correct outcome. By way of example only, following a foul being given and prior to the free kick being taken two players are sent off, one from each team.
- 1.15. We may void any bet which relates to Team to Score First and Win, if no goals are scored in such match.
- 1.16. We may void any bet with regards to a match or event (as applicable) which does not take place or if a match or event (as applicable) is determined by a Walk Over.
- 1.17. We may void any bet with respect to Group Betting: (1) if all listed participants in the relevant event do not start such event; or (2) at least one participant from the list we provide you to bet on does not finish the relevant event and the relevant governing body, association or organisation does not provide any tie-breaking conditions or procedures.
- 1.18. We may void any bet with respect to a Head to Head bet which relates to the performance of two or three participants, if all the participants from the list we provide with respect to such event do not start such event.
- 1.19. We may void your bet if any offer which specifically relates to one or more participants performance with respect to a particular event or competition (as applicable) if such participant or participants (as applicable) does not take part in such event or competition (as applicable). The foregoing may relate to a bet such as a player's performance against the field.
- 1.20. During specific events, we may decide to offer for betting a reduced selection of participants and might also include betting options such as "any other", "the field", or similar. This option includes all unlisted participants except for the ones mentioned specifically as available.
- 1.21. We may void your bet if your bet is placed on a To Qualify offer which at the time of bet placement required just one round or stage (as applicable and inclusive of any additional time or events, as applicable) for the relevant

participant to advance to the next round or stage (as applicable) if such stage or round (as applicable) has not been irrevocably concluded within 36 hours of its listed beginning.

- 1.22. Any bet which relates to an aggregate amount of occurrences by a participant in a team sport, with regards to the relevant tournament or competition (as applicable), will only take into account the occurrences whilst participant is playing in the relevant tournament or competition (as applicable). (this does not include any post season games, play offs or play outs).
- 1.23. When betting is offered on whether a participant will continue to hold a specific job description, title or position (as applicable) until a specific date or for a specific period of time (whether in politics, sport or any other field), such participant will need to hold such position continuously from when the bet is placed by you until the end of the relevant period.

By way of example only, with respect to an offer which states that **Bruno Le Maire** will be the Minister of the Economy and Finance of France on 31 January 2050, **Bruno Le Maire** must continually be the Minister of the Economy and Finance of France from the date on which you place your bet until 31 January 2050 (so if **Bruno Le Maire** resigns and is reappointed to such post you will lose your bet).

- 1.24. With respect to a Half Time bet or Full Time bet, we will void such bet if the regular time of the match is played in a different time format than the one detailed in the offer.
- 1.25. We may void a bet before or after bet settlement.
- 1.26. If we have any evidence whatsoever of any account holder acting in conjunction with another account holder, we may void the applicable bets, withhold any winnings and/or stakes whilst we investigate such matter. Depending on our conclusion with respect of such investigations we may void the applicable bets, withhold any winnings and/or stakes.

2. Our Cash Out Feature

2.1. We may provide you with the opportunity to Cash Out your bet which has not been settled and if your bet is cashed out, no further events or occurrences (as applicable) related to such bet shall apply.

By way of example only, if you place a bet of 10 Euros on the double of Everton (6/4 or 2.5) and Brighton (1/2 or 1.5) to win. Brighton win, and the Everton game is about to kick off. The Cash Out function is available and the Cash Out on

offer is 24 Euros. If you Cash Out at such point in time you guarantee yourself a profit, even if Everton lose. The 24 Euros is credited to your account, without the Everton match being played.

- 2.2. We are not obligated in any manner to provide you with the option to Cash Out your bet (even if we have done so in the past).
- 2.3. If a Cash Out is accepted by us when the result of the respective bet has already been determined, we reserve the right to void the Cash Out. We also reserve the right to void and reclaim any Cash Out where there is indication for abuse of the Cash Out feature.
- 2.4. Your Cash Out may be subject to delay including without limitation as a result of a manual delay. If during any such delay, we cease providing the offer or the odds change to which your Cash Out relates, your Cash Out request will be rejected.
- 2.5. If your bet is placed with a Free Bet Token, your Cash Out value will be the current value of the amount you can cash out minus the Free Bet Token amount.
- 2.6. We may withdraw or suspend Cash Out offers at any time.

3. Bet Types

We may provide with the opportunity to place the following types of bets:

Type of Bet	<u>Explanation</u>
Accumulator Bet, Accumulator or Parlay	Means a bet which combines four or more selections into a single bet. You will only win such bet, if all of your selections win.
Asian Handicap, Asian Spread or Asian Margin	An Asian Handicap, Asian Spread or Asian Margin is a type of Handicap (for an explanation of what is a Handicap please see below) where the selections are handicapped according to their form. This means that one participant is effectively given a head start before the game

	commences. Favourites are indicated by the (-) sign and underdogs/outsiders with a (+):
	By way of example only, with respect to a game played by Liverpool and West Ham. The Asian Handicap would be:
	Liverpool (-1.5), West Ham (+1.5), in this scenario Liverpool need to win by two goals or more for you to win your bet. If Liverpool don't win by two or more goals, you will lose your bet and those account holders who backed West Ham to get within 1.5 goals of Liverpool will win. Note, there are only two results as the draw result is eliminated.
Correct Score or Result Betting	This gives you the opportunity of betting on the exact score as at the end of the match, tournament or event (as applicable) or at the end of a pre-defined period during such match, tournament, or event (as applicable).
Draw No Bet	This type of bet removes the outcome of a tie on three-way markets. This type of bet also applies in three way offers where we do not offer odds on a tie. Should there be no winner, or the relevant occurrence has not occurred your stake will be refunded to you.
Double Chance	This provides you with the opportunity of placing a bet at the same time on two outcomes of an event, tournament, or a match (as applicable) as at the end of the match, tournament, or event (as applicable) or at the end of a pre-defined period during such match, tournament or event (as applicable).
Each Way, EW or E/W	This is essentially a bet with two separate parts (of an equal stake), one part of the bet is for the participant to win and the other part of the bet is for the participant to place in any positions offered by us.
Goal Minutes	This provides you with the opportunity to bet on the sum of minutes that goals have been scored in any match. Own goals do not count towards settlement of a Goal Minutes bet. Any

	goals scored during injury time will be considered as being scored in the last minute of the relevant half, For example, with respect to football, any goals scored in injury time of the first half are considered as if they were scored in the 45th minute and any goals scored in injury time of the second half are considered as if they were scored in the 90th minute.
Group Betting	Means where we offer a group of participants to bet on in a market. The outcome will be based on which player of the group you could bet on wins. For example in Golf: Which player will shoot the lowest round?
	Handicap, Margin or Spread betting is where one selection in an event is given a "handicap" to overcome in order to win. We may offer you the opportunity to bet on a two-way handicap, an Asian Handicap or a three-way handicap (European handicap). Handicap betting may also be referred to as "margin" or the "spread". For example, in a two-way handicap where you may bet on a winner or loser (there is no
Handicap, Margin or Spread	 handicap draw option to bet on): a. Tottenham vs. Leicester where the handicap is 0-2 (Leicester is given a two goal head start). Even if Tottenham wins the game 1-0. If you placed a handicap bet on Leicester to win, you will win your bet, because the handicap makes the score 1-2 for the purposes of the bet. b. England vs. France where the handicap is 0-3 (France is given a three goal head start). The final score was 2-0 to England. If you placed your bet on England to win, you will lose your bet because the handicap makes the score 2-3 for the purposes of the bet. c. Monaco vs. Lens where the handicap is 3 - 0 (Monaco is given a three goal head start). The final score was a 3-0 win to Lens. In such event the Push Rules will apply to your bet.

	A three-way handicap (or European handicap) provides you with the opportunity to bet on a	
	handicap draw option. For example, in a three-way handicap:	
	d. Tottenham vs. Leicester where the handicap is 0-2 (Leicester is given a two goal head start). Even if Tottenham wins the game 1-0, if you placed a handicap bet on Leicester to win, you will win your bet, because the handicap makes the score 1-2 for the purposes of the bet.	
	e. England vs. France where the handicap is 0-3 (France is given a three goal head start). The final score was 2-0 to England. If you placed your bet on England to win, you will lose your bet because the handicap makes the score 2-3 for the purposes of the bet.	
	f. Monaco vs. Lens where the handicap is 3 - 0 (Monaco is given a three goal head start). The final score was a 3-0 win to Lens, Your "score" (the score that counts for the purposes of your bet) is therefore 3-3. If you placed a bet on Monaco or Lens to win, you lose your bet. If you placed a bet on a draw, you would win the bet.	
	For an example of an Asian Handicap please see above.	
	Unless otherwise stated on the Site, all handicaps listed on the Site are determined from the beginning of the listed event or period (as applicable) to the end of the listed event or period (as applicable). However, certain handicap offers in specific sports, only the outcomes from the time of bet placement until the end of the listed period will count.	
Half Time/Full Time	This provides you with the opportunity of placing a bet on what you think the outcome will be at half time and full time of an event.	
Head to Head or Triple Head	This provides you the choice of placing a bet between two participants or three participants or two outcomes or three outcomes of an event or in a situation which is determined by us. In motor sport or golf, you could have the choice of two competitors out of a larger field.

	This gives you the opportunity of betting on the outcome as at the end of the match,

	This provides you with the opportunity of betting on a predefined odd or even occurrence at

Proposition Bets or Prop Bet

The types of Proposition Bets we offer are:

- a. Clean Sheet: you can bet that a team does not let in any goal during a game.
- a. **Grand Salami Bets:** you can bet on the total number of occurrences to materialise (as determined by us) in a specific event, round or specific period (as determined by us).
- b. **Fantasy or Virtual Matches or Head to Heads or Mythical Bets:** you can bet on the imaginary pairing of two or more participants which are not directly competing against each other in the same match, event or round (as applicable).
- c. **Quarter or Half or Period:** you can bet on the score or result (as applicable) in the relevant period determined by us or at the end of the relevant period determined by us (as applicable).
- d. <u>Over/Under Bets:</u> you can bet on the positioning of participants. "Over" is considered as a lower position or worse position (as applicable) and "Under" means a higher or better position (as applicable).
- e. Race To (or similar): you can bet on a team or participant (as applicable) reaching a certain occurrence or number of occurrences (as applicable) as defined by us and in a period of time as defined by us.
- f. Rest of Match (or similar): you can bet on a result or occurrence (as applicable) from when such bet is placed until the end of the predetermined period.
- g. Result at the end of a Quarter, Half or Period: you can bet on occurrences which must happen prior to the end of a predetermined period determined by us.
- h. **Specific Time Frames or Intervals:** you can bet on a result or occurrence (as applicable) which materialises or which occurs in aggregate during a predetermined period or interval determined by us (any Injury Time or stoppage time will not be included in such predetermined period unless we detail otherwise). No other results

	or occurrences will be applicable unless we detail such on the offer, the Site or on the relevant promotion.
	 i. <u>Team to Score First and Win:</u> you can bet on the first team to score and win.
	j. <u>Team to Win From Behind:</u> you can bet on a team from a losing position going on to
	win.
	k. Winner of or Scorer of (or similar) - this type of bet provides you with the
	opportunity of betting on an occurrence happening. No occurrence happening before
	the bet is accepted by us are taken into account.
	We reserve the right to limit the amount of combinations on offer. The types of System Bets
	we offer are a:
	a. Canadian System or Super Yankee: consists of 26 bets on five selections - one
	fivefold bet, five fourfold bets, ten treble bets and ten double bets. For you to receive
	any return on your bet, at least two of your five selections must win.
	b. Goliath System: consists of 247 bets on eight selections - one eightfold bet, eight
	sevenfold bets, 28 sixfold bets, 56 fivefold bets, 70 fourfold bets, 56 treble bets and
System or Multiple Bets	28 double bets. For you to receive any return on your bet, at least two of your eight selections must win.
	c. Heinz System: consists of 57 bets on six selections - one sixfold bet, six fivefold
	bets, fifteen fourfold bets, twenty treble bets and fifteen double bets. For you to
	receive any return on your bet, at least two of your six selections must win.
	d. Live Betting System: consists of up to twenty five selections on a single betting slip.
	All of your selections must win for you to win the bet.
	e. <u>Lucky 15 System: consists of 15 bets on four selections</u> - one fourfold bet, four
	treble bets and six double bets and four single bets. For you to receive any return on
	your bet, at least one of your four selections must win.

f. Lucky 31 System: consists of 31 bets on five selections - one fivefold bet, five fourfold bets, ten treble bets, ten double bets and five single bets. For you to receive any return on your bet, at least one of your five selections must win. g. Lucky 63 System: consists of 63 bets on six selections - one sixfold bet, six fivefolds bets, fifteen fourfolds bets, twenty treble bets, fifteen double bets and six single bets. For you to receive any return on your bet, at least one of your six selections must win. h. Patent System: consists of seven bets on three selections - one treble bet, three double bets and three single bets. For you to receive any return on your bet, at least one of your three selections must win. i. **Pre-Match System:** consists of up to twenty five selections on a betting slip. All of your selections must win for you to win such bet. j. Super Heinz System: consists of 120 bets on seven selections - one sevenfold bet, seven sixfold bets, twenty one fivefold bets, thirty five fourfold bets, thirty five treble bets and twenty one double bets. For you to receive any return on your bet, at least two of your seven selections must win. k. Trixie System: consists of four bets on three selections - one treble bet and three double bets. For you to receive any return on your bet, at least two of your three selections must win. l. Yankee System: consists of 11 bets on four selections - one fourfold bet, four treble bets and six double bets. For you to receive any return on your bet, at least two of your four selections must win. This is where you bet the same pre-determined number of points to all results in an Teaser Plus or Teaser + Accumulator/Parlay bet containing a Handicap, Totals or an amalgamation of the foregoing. Like an Accumulator/Parlay bet, you will only win this bet if all of your selections are correct.

4. Settlement of Results

General Rules

- 4.1. We aim to settle bets as quickly as possible, however in some instances, there may be a delay whist we wait for confirmation of the results or occurrence. Our Settlement of bets will be based on sources available to us including without limitation through the television, streaming as well as the websites of the governing association, body or organization (as applicable).
- 4.2. Subject to the rest of the Rules, settlement of bets will happen after the relevant event, match or tournament (as applicable) ends and the result is known. Any changes to the result after the original result published by the relevant governing association, body or organisation will not be taken into account.
- 4.3. Where we determine that the rules governing your bet are unclear or insufficient, we may settle any bet taking into account what is generally accepted betting norms, customs and definitions.

Abandoned Events

- 4.4. All bet offers that have been determined irrevocably prior to the abandonment of an event and could not possibly be altered regardless of future events, will be settled according to the decided outcome.
- 4.5. We may void any bet if an event or competition (as applicable) does not begin within 24 hours from the official start time as last issued by the governing association, body or organisation (as applicable). The foregoing shall not apply to an event or competition (as applicable) whose start time not been issued by the relevant governing body, association or organisation (as applicable) at the time which you place the relevant bet and any bets placed will not be voided by us and will remain in effect until the relevant event or competition (as applicable) takes place.
- 4.6. If an event has been abandoned prior to the events ordinary conclusion (for example with regards to a domestic league football match, the two halves of such match being completed) and the governing association, body or organisation (as applicable) provides a result with respect to such event within 24 hours of the events start, we will use such decision to settle your bet with respect to the events outcome (for example Double Chance, Draw, Match and No Bet) as long the decision provided by the governing association, body or organisation (as applicable) does not alter

the outcome of such bets at the time the relevant event was abandoned. If the outcome of such bets are altered, we will refund your stake. All offers relating to a number of occurrences happening (for example with respect to American Football, how many penalties being awarded), will be voided by us, however such will not apply if with respect to any outcomes which have been irrevocably determined prior to the abandonment of the relevant event and your bet will be settled in accordance with the relevant outcome which has been irrevocably determined.

5. Additional Rules

- 5.1. We may at any time suspend all or any betting activity. For example, if we're having technical difficulties, we may take down some and/or all betting opportunities.
- 5.2. Unless otherwise stated by us, with respect to an Outright or Place bet, we will not refund any bets relating to a participant or outcome (as applicable) which is connected to a particular participant or outcome should the participant not take part in such event or the outcome does not occur. We reserve the right to apply Rule 4 (Non Horse Racing and Non Greyhounds), on any offer that is not related to horse racing or greyhound racing and this will be stated in the bet offer or the Sport Specific Rules.
- 5.3. No refunds of bets will apply, even if the winning outcome of an event, match or tournament (as applicable) is an outcome which includes a participant that has not been listed for betting purposes.
- 5.4. We will not make any changes to any previous result (even if such result is affected by the following), if a participant in any event is disqualified, does not participate or is banned (as applicable) from taking part in the next round or part (as applicable) in any event or competition (as applicable). The disqualification, withdrawal or banning (as applicable) will be deemed to take effect from the point in time from when such participant was stopped from taking part in the event or competition (as applicable).
- 5.5. Any bet which relates to classification on a certain date, will be settled despite changes in any event or rounds or events played as (applicable). By way of example only, if you bet on Liverpool to be top of the Premier League on January 1st and Manchester City are top of the Premier League having played more games than Liverpool you will still lose your bet.

- 5.6. With regards to any Head to Head bet, your stake will be returned to your account if the Head to Head bet is between two participants and such participants have the same position or score or are eliminated at exactly the same stage. The foregoing shall not apply if the applicable governing, association, organisation or body (as applicable) implements a tie breaking procedure.
- 5.7. With regards to any Head to Head bet where the number of participants is three and there is more than one winning result, the Dead heat Rules will apply. This may result in your winnings being less than the stake placed on such bet.
- 5.8. With regards to any Head to Head bet relating to a different round or stage (as applicable) of an event, all participants must take part in the impending round or stage (as applicable) for bets to stand.
- 5.9. If an event has any pre-qualification stage or round (as applicable) in relation to such event and you bet on a participant who fails to qualify from such pre-qualification such participant will be considered to have lost to any person who has already qualified or has succeeded in qualifying and you will lose your bet.
- 5.10. If an event is postponed or moved (as applicable) within a tournament and your bet requires any participant or participants (as applicable) to complete two or greater stages in order to advance in such tournament, as long as the postponed or moved event (as applicable) is held during the relevant tournament your bet will still be considered valid.
- 5.11. Any references to home team or away team is a reference to the team actually playing at home and away as determined by the official association, body or organization (as applicable). At times we may display the bet on offer to you as you would find it in America, with the away team playing at the home team. For example, the Baltimore Ravens at the Dallas Cowboys (Baltimore Ravens @ Dallas Cowboys) means that Dallas Cowboys are the home team and the Baltimore Ravens are the away team.
- 5.12. If you bet on an event which is played at a neutral venue such bet will still stand whether or not we have provided such information in the relevant offer or how the teams are displayed on the Site.
- 5.13. We will not void your bet, if an event or match (as applicable) is moved from the ground originally designated or if there is a change to the surface that the event or match (as applicable) is to take place on. The foregoing will also not

apply, if we state otherwise in the Sport Specific Rules or the event or match (as applicable) is moved to what is considered to be the home ground of the one of the teams.

- 5.14. We will not void your bet with regards to an event or match (as applicable) which is played a neutral ground. This will apply even in the event, that we have not provided you with details that the event or match (as applicable) is being played at a neutral ground or how the participants positioning are displayed on the Site.
- 5.15. Subject to Section 5.16, If there is an inconsistency on how the participants are displayed between the Site and the official website of the relevant governing association, body or organisation and such inconsistency effects the odds materially, we will void all bets which are affected by such. For example will void your bet if on the Premier League website the match is displayed as Liverpool v Manchester United (or anything analogous thereto) and the match is displayed on the Site as Manchester United v Liverpool.
- 5.16. Your bet will stand with respect to a bet placed on an event or match (as applicable) where the so-called home-field advantage has little or no outcome on the odds with respect to such bet and in cases of neutral venues which they are used for example to play Finals or Semi Final (as applicable) even if the location can be deemed as a potential customary "home" pitch for either of the teams involved.
- 5.17. In the event that a Final or Semi Final (as applicable) is held on one of the participants home ground this will still be considered as a neutral venue despite what is displayed on the on the official website of the governing association, body or organisation (as applicable) and how they are shown on the Site.
- 5.18. Information made available by us referring to the teams, their make-up, classification or designation should be considered by you as informational only. If such information is wrong or not included, we will not void your bet unless it makes a substantial difference to the odds offered.
- 5.19. We can't assure you that all parts of an offer are accurate or in the information on the Site, as for example there may be different interpretations to materials translated from different languages. Any differences which occur from translation may not lead us to voiding your bet.

- 5.20. Any bet which relates to an aggregate amount of occurrences by a participant in a team sport, with regards to a tournament or competition (as applicable), will only take into account the occurrences whist the participant is playing in the relevant tournament or competition (as applicable).
- 5.21. If a bet relates to a period of time this means for example:
 - Within the first ten minutes- this means between 0 seconds and 9 minutes and 59 seconds
 - Between 18 minutes and 22 minutes- this means between 18 minutes and 0 seconds and 21 minutes and 59 seconds.
- 5.22. Unless detailed by us either in conjunction with the bet offer, or else in the Sport Specific Rules, bets referring to event or match (as applicable) duration which include decimals (such as .5) the relevant decimal must be completed for your bet to be won. By way of example only: (1) in Formula One race where a .5 duration is offered to bet on, with respect to how long a Formula One race will last Over/Under 75.5 minutes. Over would be 76 minutes or greater and Under would be 75:59 minutes or less; or (2) with respect to a boxing match, match where a .5 round duration is offered to bet on this differentiates between rounds, with respect to whether a boxing match is to last Over/Under 4.5 rounds, Over would be 5 rounds or greater and Under would be 4 rounds or less.
- 5.23. Unless we state otherwise, if you bet on a specific player to score one or more goals, such player's own goal will not count for such bet.
- 5.24. Medals won by a team or nation (as applicable) with respect to any event count as one medal.
- 5.25. With regards to any System Bet we may limit the number of combinations which you can choose.
- 5.26. Any reference to confederation, nationality or similar will be subject to the definition provided by the Site and not by the applicable governing association, body or organisation.
- 5.27. If any event officials have not officially recognized an occurrence, such occurrence shall not apply to your bet.

- 5.28. As a general rule, and unless we detail otherwise, we will settle offers based on an occurrence or outcome (as applicable), at the time that the game has been stopped. So for example in Rugby Union when a penalty kick is awarded and not when it is actually taken is used to settle your bet.
- 5.29. With respect to Period Betting, we will void your bet, if the Regular Time that a match is played is different to that listed in the offer.
- 5.30. Unless we detail otherwise, in the event that the governing association, body or organisation (as applicable) includes any extra rounds, match or matches (as applicable) following the conclusion of the regular season to determine the relevant classification or position (as applicable) (such as for example with regards to promotion, relegation), we will use the results and outcomes in such rounds, match or matches (as applicable) to settle the bet placed with regards to such classification or position.

6. Settlement on Certain Offers

- 6.1. We will settle the following bet types as follows:
- 6.2. With respect to bets such as "Man of the Match" and "Most Valuable Player", settlement of such bets will be based on the relevant competition organizer's determination unless we state otherwise.
- 6.3. Bets on player transfers will stand only if that player signs a contract with the new club. Loan deals do not count.
- 6.4. Any opportunity to bet on a: (1) participant attaining a certain occurrence against another individual or team; or (2) the classification on a certain date, will not be voided by us despite any changes to the number of games or rounds (as applicable).
- 6.5. Settlement of any bet which relates to a participant realizing an occurrence before another participant, is based on when the relevant occurrences materialized in the relevant events.
- 6.6. With respect to any Mythical, Virtual or Fantasy bets: We will settle such offers after the full round or event (as applicable) is complete. All offers must be settled on the same day as the round or event (as applicable) is scheduled to take place. If part of the offer is cancelled or rescheduled, then your bet will be made void. In all cases all bets are

accepted based on the selection's next calendar event or round (as applicable). If any selection within the particular offer is settled as a Walk Over then your bet will be made void.

- 6.7. If we provide you with the opportunity of betting on a participant to attain or complete a certain accomplishment against another participant, we shall settle such bet on the point in time when the relevant accomplishment was attained or completed.
- 6.8. With respect to an Outright or Place bet where you are provided with the opportunity of a number of participants to bet on and you place a bet on a participant to 'win" or 'place" in a specified position, if two or more participants tie we will settle such bet in accordance with the applicable rules governing the "Win" and "Place" bets, in the Sport Specific Rules as well as the Dead Heat Rule.
- 6.9. Settlement of an Each Way, EW or E/W bet will be based on the applicable rules governing the win and place bets in the Sports Specific Rules as well as the Dead Heat Rule.
- 6.10. All offers which relate to: (1) solely one players performance in a domestic league; or (2) Head to Head bets which relate to two players in a domestic league, will only take into account the regular season, so for example, no extra matches in any play-offs, post-season or anything similar to such will not be taken into account. This Section will not apply if we state to the contrary.
- 6.11. All offers which relate to: (1) any aggregate outcomes or occurrences (as applicable) in relation to a team's performance in a domestic league; (2) Head to Head bets with respect to two teams' performance in a domestic league; or (3) a cumulative domestic league performance, in settling your bet we will only take into account the regular season and will not take into account extra matches in any play-offs, post-season or anything similar to such. This Section will not apply if we state to the contrary.
- 6.12. With regards to bets placed on manager changes/moves. Joint managers/ will be settled under the Dead Heat Rule. Any bets inadvertently accepted after a move has already happened will be void.
- 6.13. Offers which relate to you placing a bet between two or more participants over a predefined period determined by us or over the course of a competition or event (as applicable) will be settled by us based on the result of the listed

participants. We will not take into account any of the other participants who take part in the competition or event (as applicable).

7. Rule 4 (Non Horse Racing and Non Greyhounds)

- 7.1. This Section shall not apply to horse-racing and greyhounds.
- 7.2. In the event of one participant not taking part, the odds provided with respect to the remaining participants are reduced in accordance with this Rule 4 (Non Horse Racing and Non Greyhounds).
- 7.3. The odds provided with respect to the remaining participants are reduced because it becomes easier for the other participants to win each participant will have one less participant to beat so it is more likely that it will win. Therefore an amount of money is taken out of winnings to balance the effect of the withdrawn participant.
- 7.4. If there are two or greater participants not taking part, the total reduction in the odds shall not exceed 75%. The deduction in such case will be based on the aggregate odds of the withdrawn participants.

- 8.1. For our dispute resolution mechanism please see the GTCs
- 8.2. We may suspend your account during and until any investigations we carry out are completed.

9. Disclaimer

- 9.1. IF YOU RECEIVE ANY WINNINGS OR BONUSES (OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR BENEFIT) ('BENEFITS") AS A RESULT OF ANY ERROR MADE BY US OR ON OUR BEHALF (WHETHER TECHNICAL OR MANUAL) IN CALCULATING, ALLOCATING OR DISTRIBUTING BENEFITS, WE MAY VOID THE BENEFITS AND, TO THE EXTENT THAT YOU HAVE ALREADY RECEIVED OR BEEN CREDITED WITH A PAYMENT IN RESPECT OF THE SAME, YOU WILL REPAY THAT AMOUNT TO US OR WE MAY DEDUCT IT FROM YOUR ACCOUNT.
- 9.2. THE INFORMATION CONTAINED ON THE SITE INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY STATISTICS MAY NOT BE UP TO DATE OR ERROR FREE AND WE ACCEPT NO LIABILITY IN SUCH REGARD.
- 9.3. For the avoidance of doubt, we do not take any liability for any mistake including without limitation as a result of an Error or the information on the Site is incomplete or inaccurate.
- 9.4. We may at any time withdraw any offer on the Site.
- 9.5. We may at any time edit the odds and make further changes we feel are required on the Site.

- 9.6. All the odds offered by us are offered on a dynamic basis and may be changed by us at any time. The bets which we accept are at the odds available on the Site at the time the bet was accepted by us irrespective of any other previous information made available, including without limitation on the Site or which is published in any media whatsoever (both online and off-line).

- 9.11. We may change the Live Betting schedule on the Site and we shall have no liability to you in such matters.
- 9.12. All bets placed with us through the Site may be subject to delays and we shall have no liability to you with respect to any such delay.
- 9.13. Any deadline for placing a bet is for informational purposes only.
- 9.14. In addition, we shall not be liable to you if you are unable to place a bet on Live Betting, the relevant Live Betting score has not been updated, any changes to the schedule or the interruption of the service.
- 9.15. If a Cash Out has experienced a technical error, pricing error or settlement error at any time we may correct such in accordance with the User Agreement.
- 9.16. We reserve the right to round up or round down percentages, units or other conditions which are vital for the settlement of a bet, in such cases we shall not be liable to you for any of your lost winnings or loss of stake.
- 9.17. We may modify or withdraw any offer at any time.

- 9.18. We may withhold payment to you or to declare bets void, if we believe that there is sufficient evidence that any of the following has occurred: (1) for whatever reason the integrity of the event has been called into question; (2) the price(s) or pool has been manipulated; (3) any match rigging has taken place; or (4) or the match is under investigation for match rigging.
- 9.19. The information on the Site is for informational purposes only. We accept no liability if such information is incorrect, incomplete or is not accurate.
- 9.20. We may at any time suspend any or all betting activity.

10. Betting Limits and Pay Out Limits

- 10.1. We may at any time, prior to a bet being placed by you, limit the amount of winnings (excluding stake) that you will receive if the bet is successful.
- 10.2. We may also impose additional limits on the bets that you may place (for example by limiting: (1) the type or category of bet you may place; (2) the total amounts you may stake or size of each stake you may place; or (3) the events you may bet on) ('Pre-Imposed Personal Limits"). For more information on Pre-Imposed Personal Limits please see 'section 12" within these terms.
- 10.3. In addition to the Pre-Imposed Personal Limits, the Maximum Payout Limits (which can be found in section 12) apply to any winnings from a successful bet.
- 10.4. Please note that the Pre-Imposed Personal Limits which we may place on your account may result in your winnings being limited to a lower amount than the Maximum Pay Out Limits.
- 10.5. If a Pre-Imposed Personal Limit has been reached and you wish to increase it, you can contact us via Live Chat. It will be at our sole discretion whether to answer, accept or reject any such request by you.

- 11.2. Pay outs will be based on two decimal places and we will round down such player's winnings to the nearest ore. So, for example if you win Euros 4.096, you will receive Euros 4.09.

12. Maximum Pay out Limits

- 12.5 Please note that the Pre-Imposed Personal Limits which we place on your bets or account may be lower than those Maximum Pay Out Limits.

- 12.7 The Maximum Payout Limits and Pre-Imposed Personal Limits apply to a single bet or to a combination of bets which you place including without limitation with respect to an Accumulator Bet.
- 12.8 The Maximum Payout Limits and the Pre-Imposed Personal Limits applies to both to you individually or a group of end users acting together.
- 12.9 The Maximum Payout Limits and Pre-Imposed Personal Limits still apply, will still apply, even if by accepting your bet, the level of potential winnings exceeds these amounts.
- 13 Should you place a bet made up of a combination of bets on different events or categories which have different Sports-Specific Maximum Payout Limits and/or Pre-Imposed Personal Limits, the lowest applicable Sports-Specific Maximum Payout Limit and/or Pre-Imposed Personal Limits will apply. For the avoidance of doubt your winnings will always be subject to the General Maximum Payout Limit.

- We will void single and multiple bets if the horse you bet on is announced as a non-runner prior to the race.
 However, for any bet other than an Ante Post bet (see below for further explanation of this bet type), your bet will stand if the horse you bet on comes under starters orders, but doesn't race (including for stalls starts, where the horse is left in the stalls) or tape starts, where the tape is lifted and the horse doesn't go with the field).

	3. In the event that the SP (as defined in the Prices Section below), lead to two or more horses having the shortest odds, the horse with the lowest race card number will be deemed as the Favourite.
	4. We will void your bet if at least one race is not completed as declared by the relevant race meeting organisers. The foregoing will not apply to any bet, for which the outcome has been irrevocably determined prior to the abandonment of the relevant race and your bet will be settled in accordance with the relevant outcome which has been irrevocably determined.
	5. The "Favourite" must win the race where there are four or less horses running in the relevant race, for Place Only bet purposes.
Distance	 General Rules 1. We will settle Distance bets on the distance between the first and second placed horse past the post as determined by the race meeting organisers. Such horses must have run the relevant course correctly and carried the relevant weight. If a

- horse has taken the wrong course or is carrying the wrong weight it will be ignored and the aggregate winning distance will then be calculated between the first two runners past the post who have taken the correct course and are carrying the correct weight.

- 3. You will lose your bet, if the horse which you have bet on does not run in the relevant race.

Meeting Winning

- 1. Bets are placed on the aggregate of the winning distances from one race meeting.
- 2. If at least one race is abandoned or declared void by the race meeting organisers all bets will be voided by us. The foregoing will not apply to any bet, for which the outcome has been irrevocably determined prior to the abandonment of the relevant race and your bet will be settled in accordance with the relevant outcome which has been irrevocably determined.
- 3. The following will be added to the total distance in the event of a Walkover or if the race is declared void by the meeting organisers: Flat Racing 5 lengths; National Hunt Racing 12 lengths.

Race Winning

	 Bets are placed with respect on the wining distance by a horse in a race. We will void your bet in the event of a Walkover or if the race meeting organisers do not declare a result.
Each Way and Win	1. A Win bet is a single stake on your chosen selection winning the race. An Each Way option may also be available for you to bet on. 	6. We may provide you with the opportunity of placing a bet on a "Betting Without" offer. In such event you can place a bet on whether a listed horse will be able to finish in a certain position in the race within an Each Way bet, should the listed horses not be included in the race's official result. Tattersalls Rule 4(c) Deductions (as detailed below) shall apply in the case of any non runners with respect to a "Betting Without" offer.
Forecast or Tricast	 Forecasts are accepted by us in all races of three or more actual runners and will be settled as a straight forecast (selections to finish first and second in correct order) in accordance with the computer straight forecast dividend. If there are less than three actual runners running in a race then all Forecast bets for that race will be void. Combination Tricast: This is a bet where you choose the selections to finish first, second, and third in a specified race. Straight Forecast (this may also be referred to as a Forecast): This is a bet where you choose two selections to finish first and second in any order for a specific race. Tricast: This is a bet where you choose two selections to finish first and second in any order for a specific race. Tricast: This is a bet where you choose the selections to finish first, second, and third in the correct order for a specified race.

Match	 Match bets refer to which of two horses, finish highest at the end of the race or at the end of a pre-defined part of the race as determined by us (as applicable). If one of the horses relating to your bet falls or fails to complete the race, we will settle your bet based on the horse which has run the further distance in the race.
	3. We will void your bet, if neither of the horses which relate to your bet start the relevant race.
	4. We will settle your bet based on the result published by the race organisers.
Place Only	1. A Place Only bet is a bet on your horse to place. Your bet is a winner if your horse places. We will settle your bet in the same way that the Place part of an Each Way bet is settled as detailed above.

If betting is available during a race, then the SP will be the last available odds for the selection. SP isn't available for Ante Post bets. Early Prices (which may also be referred to herein 'EP") are the odds normally offered from the morning of the day of the race (although sometimes they may be offered from the evening before). Tattersalls Rule 4 (c) Deductions

- If a horse is withdrawn and does not come under starter's orders, a non runner or is officially deemed by the starter to have taken no part in the race we will apply Tattersall's Rule 4 (c).
- Tattersalls Rule 4 (c) Deductions are made when a horse is withdrawn from a race because it becomes easier for the other runners to win each horse in the race will have one less to beat so it is more likely that it will win. Therefore an amount of money is taken out of winnings to balance the effect of the withdrawn runner. TROTTING

- In the event of a tie the Dead Heat Rule applies to all bets.

- The bullet point above will not apply and we will void your bet, in the event that the listed race or meeting (as applicable), is not held or completed on the date it is scheduled to be held, if such bet is placed following 00:00 CET of the scheduled day. However, your bet will stand, if you place the bet prior to 00:00 CET on the scheduled day as long as the race or meeting (as applicable) is held in the same calendar year as the scheduled day.
- Your bet will still stand even in the event that there is any inaccuracy in the published information on the Site or any other material provided by us regarding the race, including without limitation an error in the race distance, race name, race number, start numbers or how the race is to start, provided that all the horses on which you have the opportunity to bet on, take part in the relevant race or meeting (as applicable).

- The settlement of your bet is based on the outcome of any regular time as well as any overtime played, or (if applicable) on any sudden death overtime played which is also known as the Golden Point Rule, unless we detail otherwise.
- If you place a bet with respect to any Margin Bet or any Half Time or Full Time Bet, we will settle your bet with the result at the end of regular time (80 min play) at the end of the match (i.e. overtime or Golden Point Rule does not count).

- Despite the bullet point above, we will settle or resettle (as applicable) your bet your bet in the event that the relevant governing body, association or organization (as applicable) alters its original official result within 24 hours following the relevant heat or the final stage of the competition (as applicable). Such change to the original official result must be attributable to incidents which have occurred during the relevant race or event.
- For the avoidance of doubt, following such 24-hour period, the official result in force at such time will be considered as the final and binding result.
- With respect to settling your bet, if a swimmer false starts and is disqualified such swimmer is deemed to have taken part in the race.

- If the relevant association, body or organisation with respect to the relevant sport announces a result for an event, such result will be used by us to settle your bet including without limitation if the relevant event is shortened or moved to a different venue or slope.

The foregoing will not apply if the relevant event which has been cancelled, interrupted or postponed is completed within 48 hours of the displayed start time on the Site (this will apply to you, if any additional games or additional maps that were supposed to be part of the same matchup are cancelled or further postponed).
- Settlement of your bet: Unless otherwise stated in these rules: (i) We will settle your bet based on the official broadcast of the game by the publisher of such game or event organizer (as applicable).
